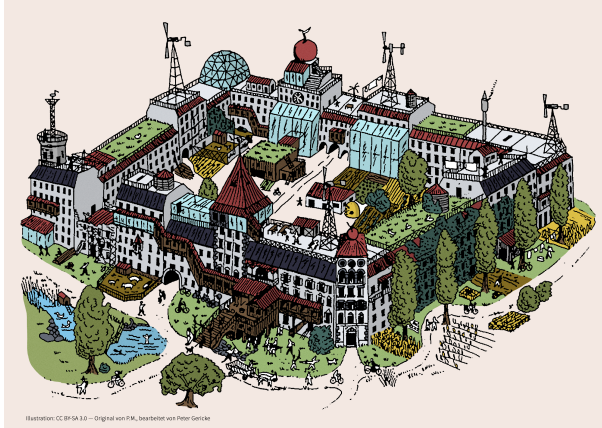


Housing for Degrowth: **Barcelona Book Launch**

Co-editors François Schneider and Anitra Nelson, and contributors Joan Martinez-Alier and Mara Ferreri, reveal how their recently published *Housing for Degrowth: Principles, Models, Challenges and Opportunities* breaks new ground — applying a degrowth approach to housing, offering a holistic set of principles, demonstrating grassroots achievements, and need for policy changes to optimise bottom-up efforts.

This new book in the Routledge Environmental Humanities series collection includes a useful section with a debate between degrowth advocates on urbanisation, decentralisation and open localism. Anitra Nelson (Centre for Urban Research, RMIT University, Melbourne) and François Schneider (ICTA, University Autonomus Barcelona) will draw on their own research and experiences, and identify key degrowth interventions and lessons presented by the more than 20 contributors to their book. Emeritus Professor Joan Martinez-Alier of ICTA, University Autonomus Barcelona (UAB) will speak along with a chapter author Mara Ferreri (UAB).
